Introduction

Feedback is an essential element of teaching learning process. The college collects feedback on curriculum for various courses online from different stakeholders such as students, alumni, faculty and employer through google form. Stakeholder in education is anyone who has an interest in the success of an educational system. Different stakeholders have different perspectives of how a curriculum should be designed. Separate structured questionnaire using google forms were prepared for each stakeholder to collect feedback on various aspects of the curriculum wherein they were asked to rate on a five-point scale with 5 meaning excellent, 4 very good, 3 good, 2 averages and 1 poor. The forms were distributed via WhatsApp groups to reach out to student groups, faculty, alumni and the employers and link is also provided in the college website.

Students' Feedback Analysis

The college is affiliated with University of Mumbai. It follows the syllabus prescribed by the university. The Students' Feedback forms on curriculum is designed to get formative feedback from students that can be used towards the improvements in the quality of course design and delivery, as well as student learning experiences. In order to get students' view on syllabus, Course wise data was collected by Google form. Various questions regarding the size, depth, the course content, its organization, curriculum's adaptability towards industry and future learning, were asked.

Teacher's Feedback Analysis

Teachers are the stakeholders who plan, design, teaches, implement and evaluate the curriculum. Their involvement in the process of curriculum development is important to align content of curriculum with students' needs. Course wise feedback on various aspects of curriculum is collected from all the faculty members. The course curriculum is evaluated on the factors such as organization of content, scope of innovative teaching, components to inculcate ethical value, industry orientation, availability of supporting instructional materials etc. Majority of the teachers strongly agreed that curriculum is industry oriented, flexible for enrichment, based on recent trends and innovative ideas.

- The analysis of the teachers' feedback reflects the adequacy and efficacy of the course curriculum.
- The feedback from the teachers revealed that the syllabus is up to date in terms of current trends and the course contents are designed according to the need of employability as well as for future learning.

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

All the respondents felt that no change was required in the curriculum.





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Observations:

More than 80% of the respondents rated the BSc Chemistry course highly in terms of employability, relevance to real life and future learning. A similar percentage felt that the curriculum was very effective in delivering the content. Around 70 % also felt that the syllabus was effective in the building of their careers and inculcated values that helped them in becoming better citizens.

Suggestions for removing older and dated theories and devoting more time to complex topics were received.

Conclusion and Recommendations

Collecting and analyzing feedback from different stakeholders becomes very important to search for ways to make best even better. The feedback from each group helps us to understand their expectations and address general concerns to improve the curriculum design and ultimately achieve the learning outcome.

Opinions of the stakeholders such as students and teachers are taken and analyzed. Analysis of responses concludes that the syllabus of BSc Chemistry program of Mumbai University is excellently designed and at par of industry standards. The feedback shows that the course content is relevant and current.

Recommendations:

For most of the courses no changes are recommended. In some of the course, better organization of topics with examples of real-life applications and inclusion of more practicals is recommended. In organic chemistry, suggestion for more focus on green Chemistry, in inorganic chemistry Suggestions for inclusion of Molecular Orbital theory in greater detail and in analytical chemistry Suggestion for inclusion of details on instrumentation was received. More complex topics can be introduced in a phase wise manner.
